Orange Shirt Day and National Day of Truth and Reconciliation

Orange Shirt Day and National Day of Truth and Reconciliation honor the lost children and survivors of residential schools, their families and communities. Commemoration and acknowledgement of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is an important part of the reconciliation process. In observance of these days, the Canadian Flag will be lowered to half mast on Monday, September 29th until Wednesday, October 1st.

Students and staff are encouraged to wear orange on September 29th. Kidd staff will be doing activities with students connected to Orange Shirt Day and Truth and Reconciliation. The school will be closed on Tuesday September 30th for Truth and Reconciliation Day.

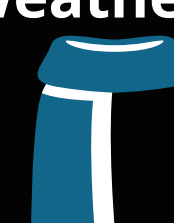

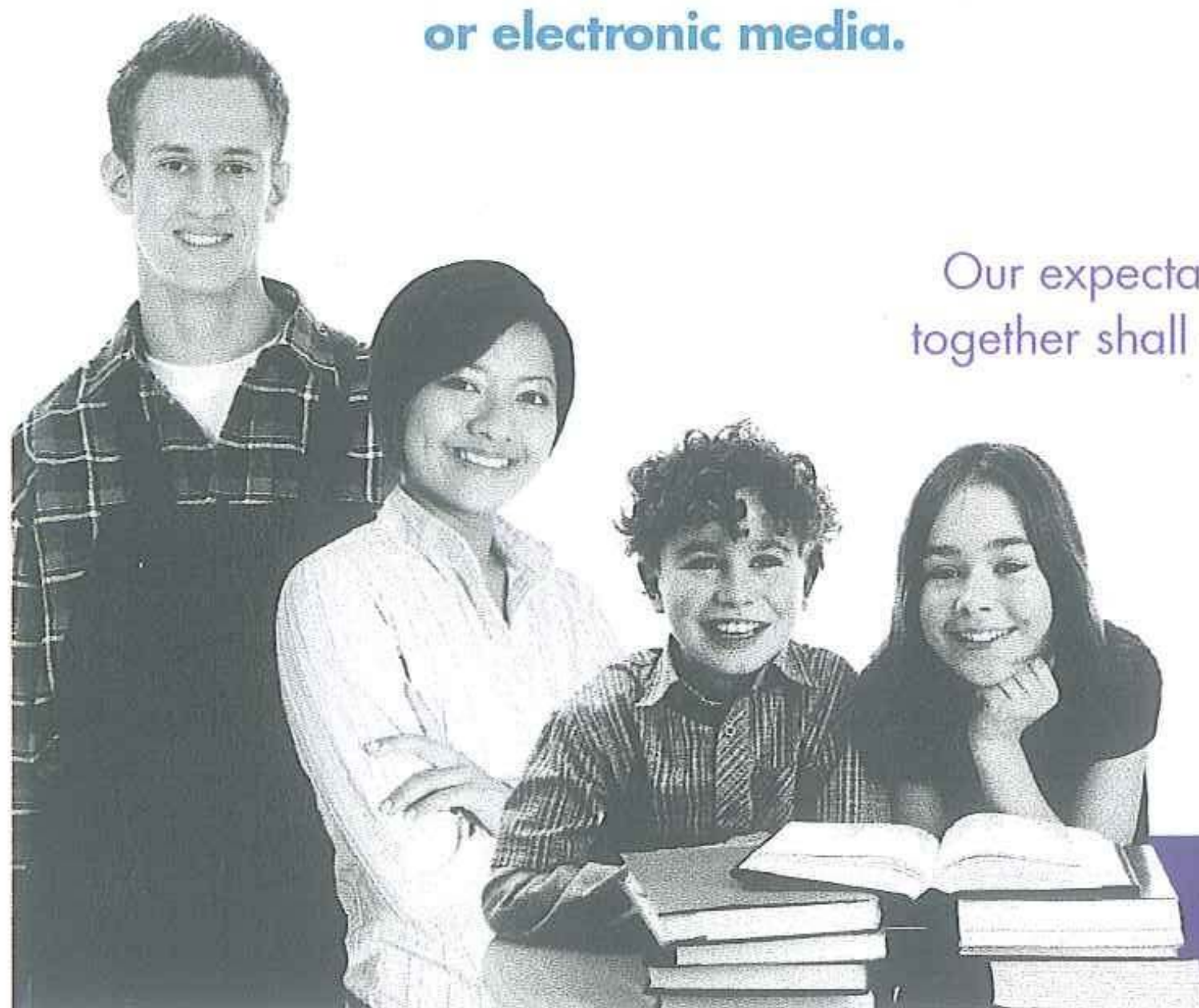


HOW WE LEARN AND WORK TOGETHER
