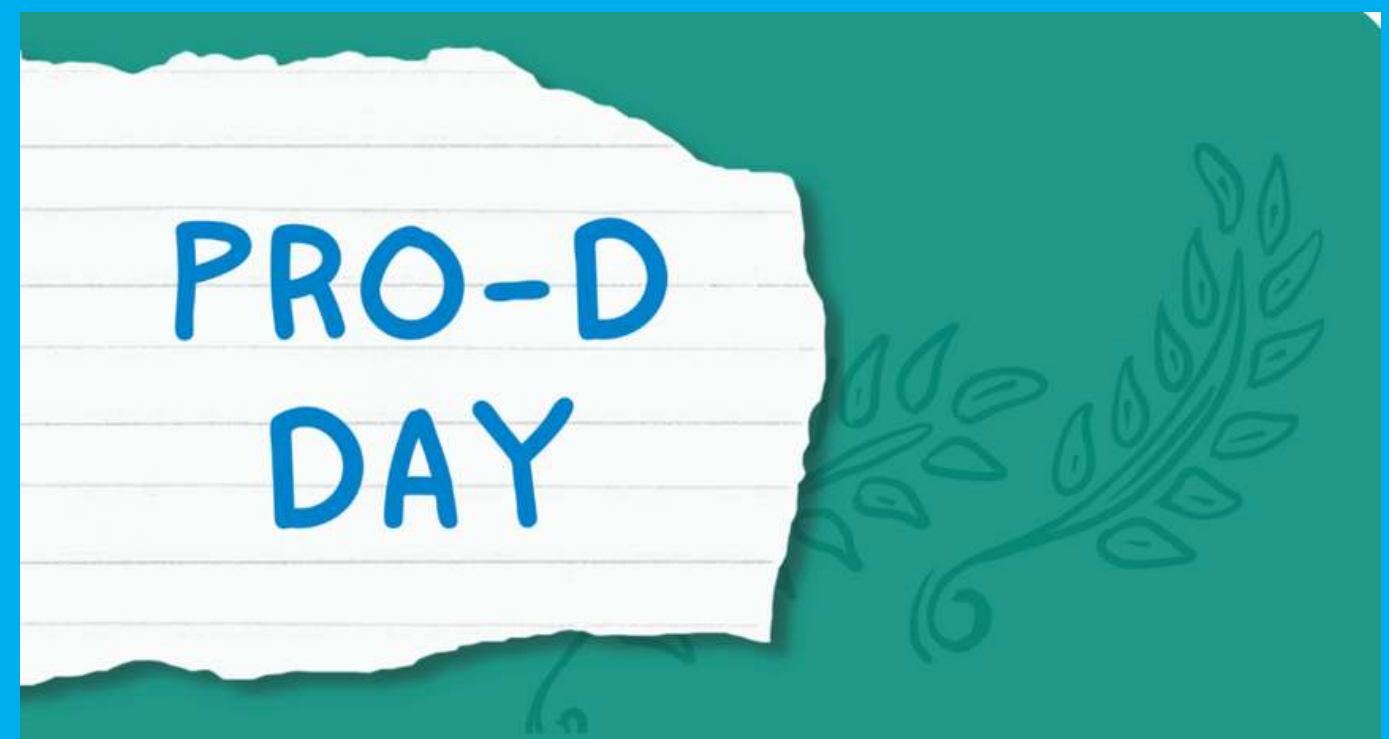


Shuffle Dance Program at Kidd

New Volunteer Driver Form

There is a new process for volunteer drivers. Starting in January all volunteer drivers are asked to complete a criminal record check and provide vehicle insurance documents showing at least 1 million dollars in third party liability. The criminal record check is free of charge. Information can be found on the school website. Your child's classroom teacher will also be able to help you with the forms that need to be completed. *If you have already filled in a driver form form for this school year, you do not need to complete a criminal record check. This is only for drivers who have not filled one out this year.*

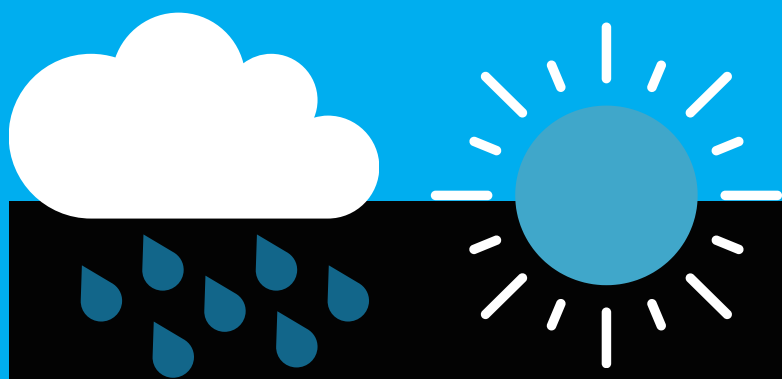
Daily Health Check

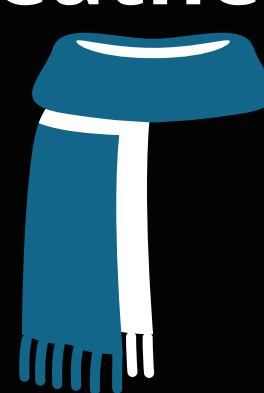
