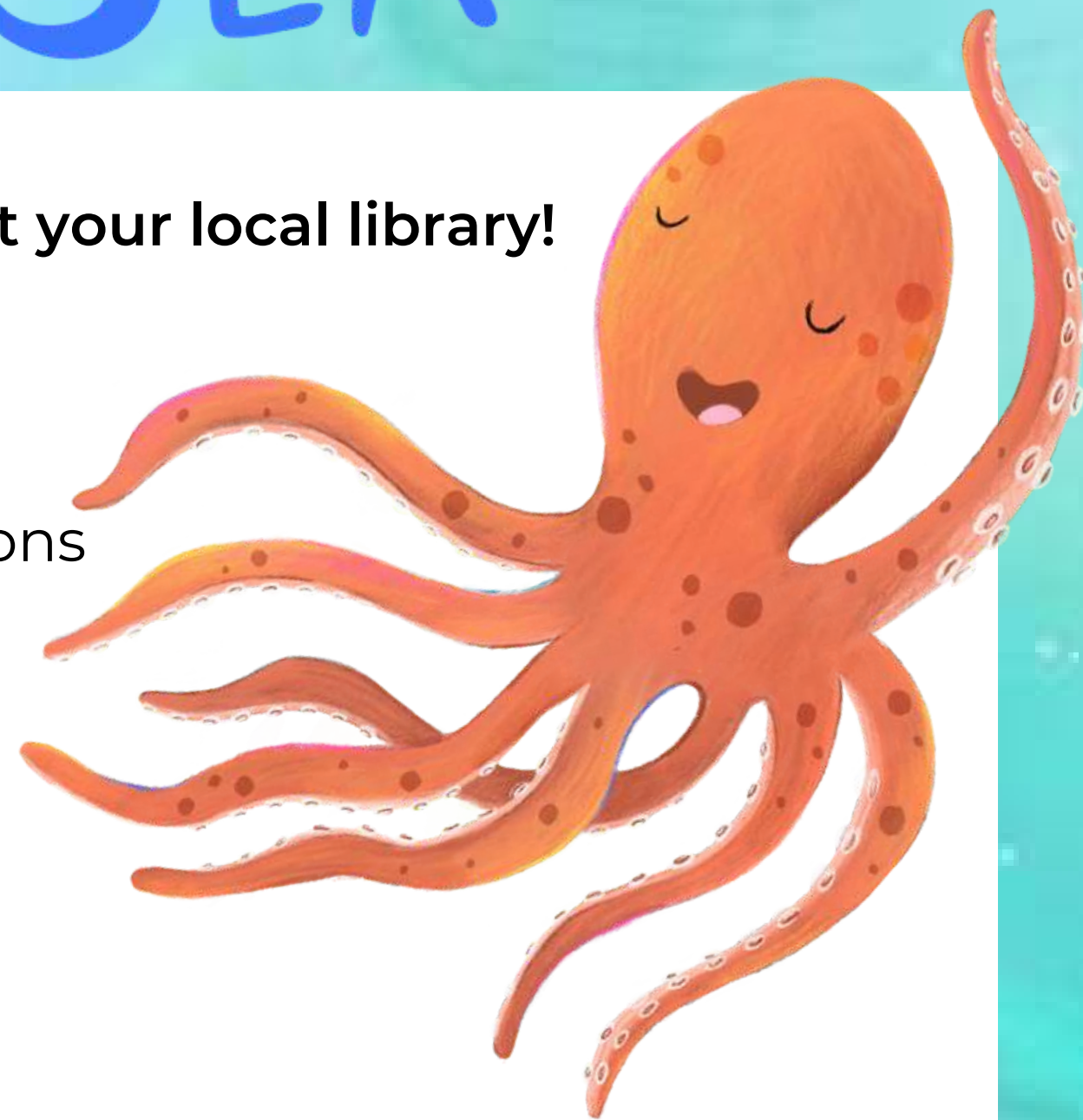
BC Summer Reading Club 2026

Important dates:

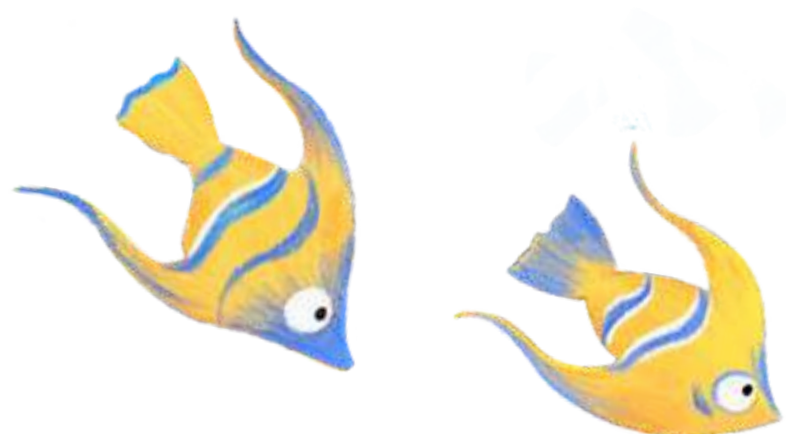
- **June 24** - Booklets available at all RPL locations
