


# Daily Health Check

# **Dress for the weather!**


It is starting to get cold outside. Please make sure your child feels comfortable by dressing for the weather.

### **Canadian Dental Care Plan**

Eligibility: Do not have access to dental insurance

- Have an adjusted family net income of
- less than \$90,000Be a Canadian resident for tax purposes
- Have filed your tax return in the previous year
- Children must be under 18 years old
- If your child has dental insurance through a provincial, territorial or federal government social program, **they can still qualify** for the Canadian Dental Care Plan
