Next week we will be having our first community event. We hope that you can make it to the Meet the Staff evening on Friday. This year we are trying something new (see below). Have a great weekend!






Please talk to Mr. Cherry if you have any concerns about the parking lot. We are committed to the safety of our community and we appreciate your help.
