Upcoming Cultural Holidays & Commemorative Days of Recognition

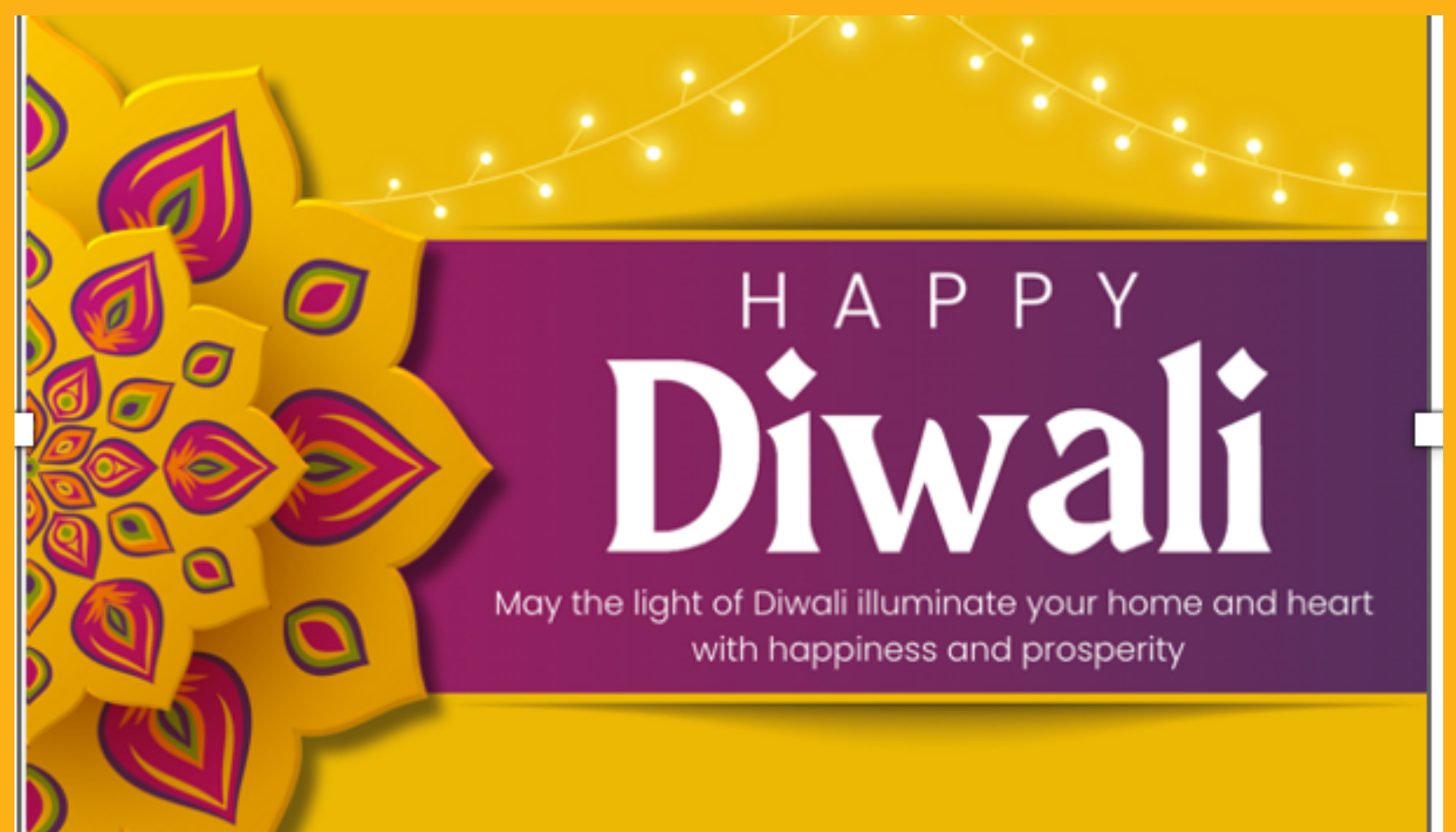

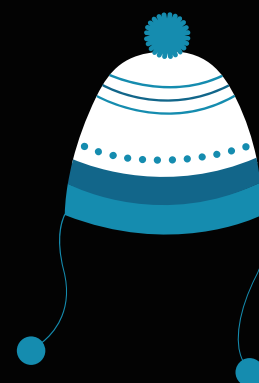

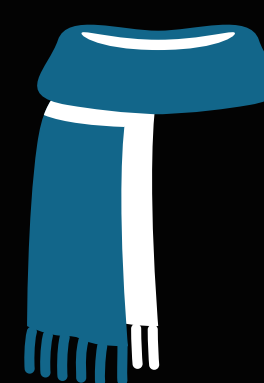
