
Early Warning Line for Absences


Conferences



New Volunteer Driver Form

There is a new process for volunteer drivers. Starting in January all volunteer drivers are asked to complete a criminal record check and provide vehicle insurance documents showing at least 1 million dollars in third party liability. The criminal record check is free of charge. Information can be found on the school website. Your child's classroom teacher will also be able to help you with the forms that need to be completed. *If you have already filled in a driver form for this school year, you do not need to complete a criminal record check. This is only for drivers who have not filled one out this year.*



Digital Citizenship at Kidd


In our older classes, we've been talking about digital citizenship and respectful communication with students at school. Recently, we've become aware that some of the chats happening outside of school include comments that are not kind or appropriate.

While we talk about these topics in class, it is incredibly helpful when families also check in on their child's online communication. Supervising chats, reviewing message history together, and having open conversations about online behaviour can go a long way in helping children make safe and respectful choices. Typically the school will not get involved in incidents that happen outside of school hours or the weekend unless it impact students in the school.




