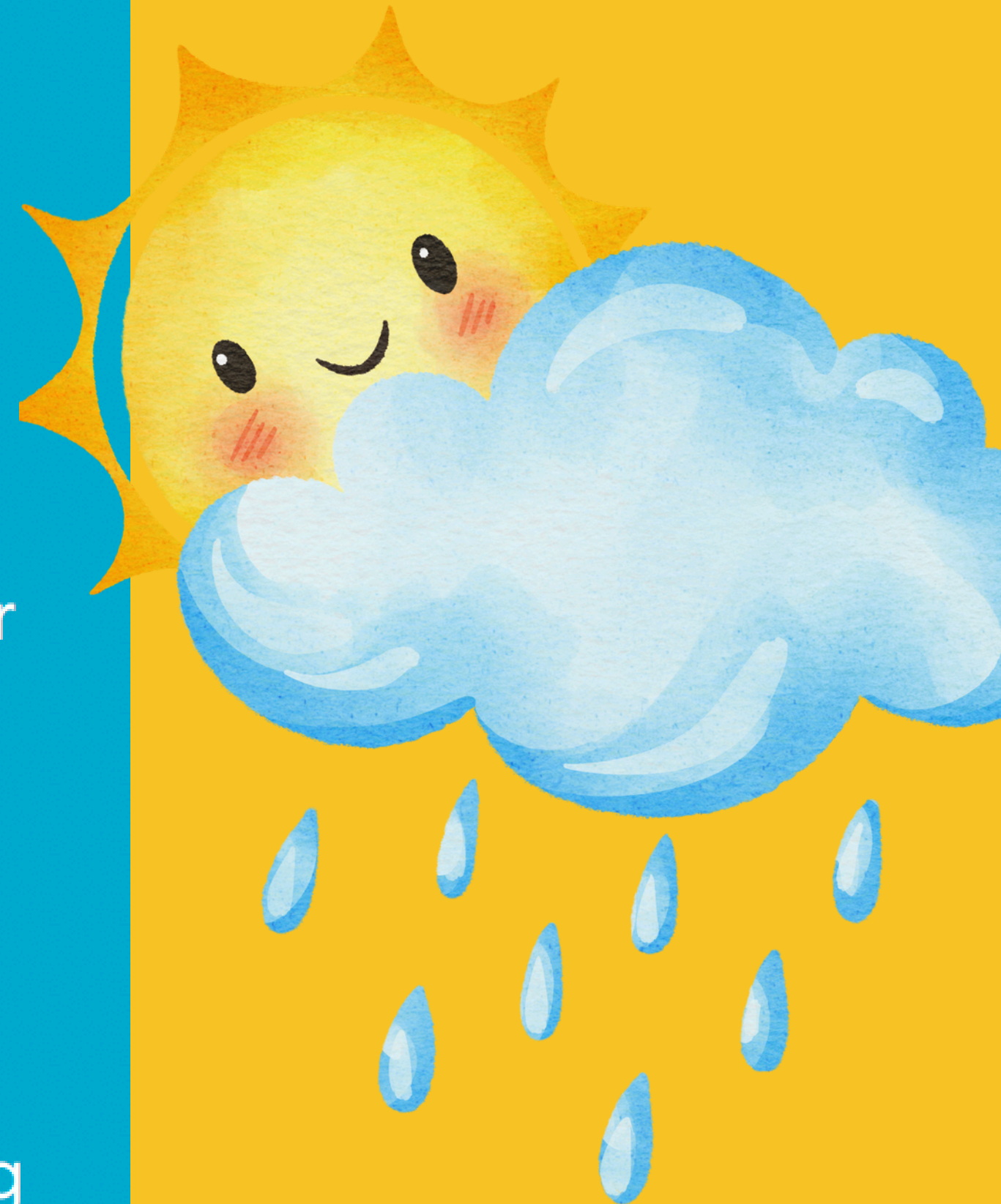
SHOULD I GO TO SCHOOL TODAY?
